L'OVILE

L'Ovile is a social cooperative established in Reggio Emilia (Emilia-Romagna Region, Italy) in 1993, with the aim to promote the inclusion of disadvantaged people.

According to Italian Law 381/91 the organization is a cooperative of type A and B. Within sector A L'Ovile manages structures aimed at the rehabilitation of people subject to criminal measures alternative to detention.

Structures are planned as educative setting aimed at social reintegration and reduction of crime risk. Labour integration in the cooperative is part of the educational path.

Since 2016 L'Ovile runs the Restorative Justice Centre "Anfora" of Reggio Emilia, which delivers mediation services between offender and victim in the field of juvenile delinquency and Justice of Peace; services supporting the reparation process in ordinary justice and in criminal enforcement; services of mediation in conflictive situations in the world of school, in social and health services, among relatives.

NOESSO

The non-profit association NOESSO manages Supportive Housing for the Reinsertion, that aims to facilitate full reintegration into society for people who need specialized help to make it effective and full.

The Housing Support Program for Reintegration proposes intervention at a psychological, educational and social level, through psychotherapeutic activities, occupational workshops and labor insertion and integration programs in the environment.

NOESSO, in collaboration with the Department of Equality and Social Policies of the Junta de Andalucía, manages a Minors Centre addressed to children aged 12 to 18 years who have serious behavioral behaviors that prevent them from full and adaptive individual and social development. A multidisciplinary team works in a coordinated way to respond to the needs of children in different contexts (individual, family, residential, school, community, health ...).
